

COPYRIGHT LICENCE AGREEMENT

1. This copyright license agreement (the “Agreement”) is made between IT Governance Publishing Ltd, company number 06082604 registered in England with offices at Unit 3, Clive Court, Cambridgeshire Business Park, Ely, CB7 4EA Cambridgeshire (“IT Governance Publishing Publishing”), and You (the individual or organisation that purchased this GDPR Data Protection Policy Template, which can be confirmed by an official, original invoice issued by an authorised IT Governance Publishing distributor) and is effective from the date (as evidenced by the invoice) on which you made the purchase.
2. IT Governance Publishing owns the copyright in all the content material (whether slide presentations, manuals, procedures, guidance notes, or information or any kind) contained within the GDPR Data Protection Policy Template (the “Material”) that you have purchased, as well as in any upgrades or updates or any sort that may, from time to time, be made available to you.

5. This license does not include the right to deploy the Material in more than one GDPR project and, where a single organisation operates more than one GDPR project, the Material is licensed for deployment in only one of them.
6. The license does not extend to any IT Governance Publishing trademarks that may be contained within the Material, all of which should be removed prior to deployment in your organisation.
7. The license does not include copyright in any software or other computer program that may be incorporated in the Material and which are the property of other organisations.
